Annotation: The report focuses on the formation and development of the resort system in the USSR. It highlights the role of the political leadership, health authorities, and trade unions in organizing and financing an extensive network of sanatoriums, holiday resorts, and health centers. Emphasis is placed on the accessibility of resort services for the population, as well as on the rules for medical selection and referral of patients (adults, adolescents, and children) for sanatorium-resort treatment. Information is provided on the most famous resorts in the USSR and Soviet Ukraine.


The report contains data on Soviet balneology as a comprehensive scientific field, including key theoretical and applied problems studied by Soviet scientists and physicians.
